

Instructions for Activity 2

There are two datasets enclosed. Each dataset represents a single, independent social network of ten people (i.e., the two datasets are unrelated to each other).

Each dataset contains ten worksheets, both in PDF and Word formats. Each worksheet corresponds to a particular person in the social network. Students should fill out their worksheet, and then the class can discuss the results (who has more friends than their friends do, who has fewer, etc.). You can choose to use one or both of the datasets; they are independent of each other. So a class of twenty students could be split into two groups of ten (one per dataset) or could use only one of the datasets and have two people complete each worksheet. A class with fewer than ten students could have students complete more than one worksheet.
